Following are some new formulas for exercises in rendering the fingers independent. By practising them slowly, observantly and intelligently, remarkable results will be obtained.

I again insist, as in my earlier works, on slow and watchful practice. Progress will be in proportion to the care bestowed.

All these exercises are to be transposed after the following model. At the very beginning, one should practise *piano*; then *mezzo-forte*; till later, *forte*. The exercises must follow this modulatory pattern in the same manner as the preceding exercises.

Series II
