CAN FD Protocol: Send and receive messages with Simulink using the CAN FD protocol

This release provides a new library of Simulink blocks to support CAN FD communication. The CAN FD Communication library includes the following blocks. For more information, see the reference page for each block.

- CAN FD Configuration
- CAN FD Transmit
- CAN FD Receive
- CAN FD Pack
- CAN FD Unpack

These blocks offer full support for the CAN FD protocol, while the workflow for using them is similar to that for the existing CAN blocks.

XCP Protocol: Communicate with ECUs from Simulink using XCP over UDP, or from MATLAB using XCP over UDP and TCP

Vehicle Network Toolbox functionality in MATLAB® now supports XCP protocol communication over UDP or TCP. The xcpChannel function is enhanced to accept 'UDP' or 'TCP' as the transport layer argument, followed by arguments specifying the IP address and port values. For example:

xcpChan = xcpChannel(A2LfileObj, 'TCP', IPaddr, portNmbr)

A new XCP UDP Transport Layer block accommodates Simulink XCP communication over UDP. This new block is in the XCP Communications library. For more information, see the XCP UDP Transport Layer block reference page.

XCP Protocol: Tune characteristics and read/write values with computation method scaling in MATLAB

This release supports scaling and direct memory reading and writing for XCP channel axes, characteristics, and measurements. For more information, see the reference pages for the following new functions:

Compatibility Considerations

As part of this enhancement, the A2L parser returns an object from xcpA2L with more properties and of different types. In previous releases, many of the xcp.A2L object properties were structures; but now there are more properties, and those that used to be structures are now objects. Accessing the content of these properties using dot notation should work the same way; but other means of access might require modification.

MDF: Read entire file content in a single function call

The MDF read function has been enhanced to allow you to read the entire MDF file contents with a single call. To read the whole file, call the read function with only the MDF file object as an argument; for example:

data = read(mdf0bj)

Linux Platform Support: Encode and decode CAN or CAN FD messages and communicate on virtual channels on Linux

This release supports encoding and decoding CAN and CAN FD messages on MathWorks virtual channels on Linux®. This support does not include other vendors, hardware, or protocols.

Note You cannot run on Linux any Simulink® models that contain blocks from the Vehicle Network Toolbox XCP Communication or J1939 Communication block libraries.

Hardware Support: Connect to additional Vector CAN interface devices

MDF InitialTimestamp: Improved resolution and more time zones

The MDF object returned from the mdf function now has an InitialTimestamp property value of a datetime type with nanosecond resolution.

The function now returns a UTC value for this property, or if that's not available, a local time. If the value is local time, you must account for its offset from other time zones. If no start time can be determined, it returns an empty datetime.

Compatibility Considerations

Previous versions of the toolbox returned an InitialTimestamp only for UTC, with a resolution of 1 second.

CAN FD Protocol: Send and receive messages with MATLAB using the CAN FD protocol

Vehicle Network Toolbox now supports the ISO CAN FD protocol in MATLAB for all vendors, including MathWorks virtual channels, for raw messages and message definitions from DBC files.

The following functions are updated to accommodate the new ProtocolMode property with its 'CAN FD' value, and the bus timing configuration necessary for CAN FD. See each function reference page for more information and examples.

Simulink Bus Objects: Simplify Simulink block diagrams by choosing Simulink Bus Signals when configuring CAN blocks

The blocks provided in the CAN Communication block library of Vehicle Network Toolbox now support the use of Simulink bus objects.

Among these blocks, the CAN Pack, CAN Receive, and CAN Replay block parameters have a new **Output as bus** option, to output a native Simulink bus signal.

Hardware Support: Connect to additional National Instruments USB CAN interface devices

Timetable Formatted CAN Messages and Signals: Receive and import data in timetables, and convert existing message objects to timetables

When dealing with CAN messages and signals, the use of timetables instead of arrays of objects can offer significant performance and display improvements. For general information on timetables, see Timetables.

J1939 and CAN Signal Values No Longer Clipped by Database Limits

When encoding or decoding signals to or from messages on the CAN bus, MATLAB and Simulink no longer clip the signal values at the minimum and maximum defined in the database file. This updated behavior is now consistent with the J1939 protocol.

Compatibility Considerations

In past releases, the signal values were clipped to fall within the range defined by the database file minimum and maximum. Signals are no longer automatically clipped in this way.

Vehicle Network Toolbox now supports hardware triggering from National Instruments NI-XNET devices and National Instruments DAQ devices.

You can configure synchronization and triggering with the StartTriggerTerminal property on the NI-XNET CAN channel object. This property string value configures a synchronization-trigger connection to start the NI-XNET CAN channel on the connected source terminal.

 BusStatus — Protocol level status of the network indicating potential error or bus off states

Discontinued support for NI-CAN devices

You now have the option to filter incoming messages in the CAN Tool and display only the messages you want to see, using message IDs. See Monitoring CAN Message Traffic for more information.

Deployable Code Generation in the CAN Blocks

You can now generate code from Simulink blocks in Vehicle Network Toolbox. Models containing the CAN Receive, CAN Transmit, and CAN Configuration blocks run successfully in Accelerator, Rapid Accelerator, External, and Deployed Modes. These blocks also now support using the Simulink Coder™ packNGo function.

receiveRaw function Removed

The receiveRaw function no longer works in the current release of Vehicle Network Toolbox.

Compatibility Considerations

You cannot access direct signal properties or use the canMessageCompatibilityMode function to restore access to direct signal properties starting with the current release of Vehicle Network Toolbox. Update your code to access physical signal values through the Signals property of message objects.

The toolbox now transmits, receives, and processes messages at a faster rate. The Transmit and Receive blocks transmit and receive messages at a faster rate.

Removal of the receiveRaw Function

The receiveRaw function will be removed in a future release. In earlier software versions, the receiveRaw function expedited receive capability with minimal processing time and maximized message throughput. With enhanced toolbox performance this capability is no longer required. Performance of the standard receive function is significantly increased and you can use it to receive all messages.

Compatibility Considerations

The receiveRaw function will be removed in a future release. You will see a warning when you use this function. Use the receive function instead.

New Signals Property for CAN Message Functions

The Signals property displays each physical signal as defined for a CAN message in the CAN database. The Signals property is not applicable if you are not using a CAN database.

Signals displayed by the Signals property replaces access to direct signal property display of CAN messages. It has also increased the toolbox performance and the throughput of the message receive and transmit functions.

Compatibility Considerations

Direct signal properties will no longer appear in a message output. Use the new Signals property to access physical signal values. Update your code if you are using a CAN database and direct signal properties. Refer to the Signals property for more information. It is recommended that you update your code and use the new Signals property because all access to direct signal properties will be removed in a future release. If you cannot update your code at this time, you can use the canMessageCompatibilityMode function to restore access to direct signal properties.

New BusLoad Property

The BusLoad property displays the load on the CAN bus associated with the CAN message traffic on Kvaser devices.

Enhanced filterSet Function

The filterSet function now automatically calculates and applies the best case filter settings from an array of CAN IDs.
